ANNUAL REPORT 1982/83

The season just completed must rate amongst the best in the 13 year history of our club. Total registrations numbered 112 - made up of 70 boys and 42 girls, an overall increase of 33% on last year and 60% on three years ago.

Whilst our membership is the highest in the club's history and we now rank as second largest club in the Diamond Valley; of much greater significance is our weekly participation and attendance. Average weekly attendance of 77 is an increase of approximately 100% in just three years.

New Developments

The Enthusiastic input and co-operation of the committee has resulted in the following:-

- (1) Introduction of 'Gold Star' awards for personal best achievement a very popular and meaningful innovation.
- (2) Design of a 'Club Logo' which has now been incorporated in our letterhead and produced on cloth badges.
- (3) Revised fee structure has placed the club in a sound financial position and resulted in acquisition of new equipment. Furthermore, all championship fees (\$176), relay fees (\$60) and inter-centre championship fees (\$50) were met by the club.
- (4) Use of high jump equipment and storage facilities for Wednesday training was successfully negotiated with Rosanna Golf Links Primary School.

Financial

Club funds as at 21 March 1983 total \$801.02. A detailed statement of Income and Expenditure is attached, however main points can be summarized as follows:-

- Total income exceeded \$5,000 which is almost double the previous season.
- Major contributor to income was Saturday competition fees followed by fund raising, Registration Fees and uniform sales.
- Major items of expenditure were various fees paid to Diamond Valley totalling \$1,520 followed by our Presentation night and cost of uniforms.

Training

The success of training during the season was due to some very reliable and hardworking people within the club.

We are all most appreciative of the efforts of Barry Carozzi, Graeme Lyons, Rod Yin, Ron Stafford, Russell Thomas and the many others who made training a worthwhile experience for the children.

A coaching clinic conducted by Ivanhoe Amateur Athletic Club on 17th November, 1982 was also very well attended. Considerable benefit was gained, particularly in the technique events of walking, jumping and throwing.

Competition

The children are to be congratulated on a fine season and some very good performances. The final interclub ladder placed Rosanna third of the nine clubs in the competition.

- 3. Competed on a minimum of seven Saturdays during the season, consisting of four before and three after the Christmas break.

The points are awarded on the pentathlon system for events contested. Our club "POINTS SCORER" calculates and collates the points earned by each child to determine the medal winners. My sincere thanks to Bob Symons for a difficult job well done.
