CLUB PRESENTATION Medals are awarded by our club to children for their performances over the season. To qualify for medals, a child must compete in a minimum of eight Saturdays throughout the season and this must include two Saturdays after the Christmas break. Days cancelled by rain and reported over the radio are

regarded as attendance days.

Our points are awarded on the pentathlon system of scoring, which gives a certain amount of points based on times and distances. Points are adjusted according to a age group. As the Centre awards are based on a different system, some discrepancies between Club and Centre awards may occur. In some events because of times and distances achieved by some children, no points would have been awarded to them. This could mean that a child who did not enter an event because he did not like it, had an advantage over the child who did enter. Therefore, it was decided that 5 bonus points be awarded for every event a child competed in.

If a child attends the track and competition is cancelled because of rain, but not reported over the radio, 5 points per event is allowed as an attendance bonus on that day.
