The average daily attendance was 49 compared with 40 last season. Percentage wise gives a better picture of attendances ... 68.5% this year compared to 60% last season. CLUB PRESENTATION

Medals are awarded by our club to children for their performances over the Season. To qualify for medals a child must compete in a minimum of 8 Saturdays throughout the Season and must include 2 weeks after the Christmas break. Days cancelled by rain are regarded as, attendance days and absenteeism by injury is left to the descression of the Committee. Our Points are awarded on the pentathlon system of scoring which gives a certain amount of points based on times or distances. These are a greater number of points per event and this can mean a discrepency between Club and Centre Awards. We found that in some events because of times and distances of some children no points would have been awarded to some children. This could mean a child who did not attend 1 week or did not like an event and missed it, was not at a disadvantage to some of the children that competed, so it was decided that 5 points be awarded for every event a child competed in.

If a child attends the track and it is cancelled because of rain, but not reported over the Radio, 5 points would be allowed as an attendance bonas on that day. This will take effect from next season.
