Please find below a statement made by me as the Centre Chairman at the Rosanna Club meeting on Tuesday 21st November 1978, re the motion that your executive moved and passed at a Special Meeting called by me on the 11th October 1978 and also the 18th October 1978 on the points regarding competition on October 7th 1978.

Your Executive passed this motion having in mind that all children were entitled to points for competition which they compete in.

We as a Centre Executive have one thing in mind that is we are all there for the children and when we forget this it is not what Little Athletics is all about and not individuals seeking gold.

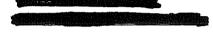

Dear Mrs. Cain,

Thank you for your letter of 16th March, 1979, concerning your proposed transfer to the Diamond Valley Centre.

As far as we in Central Office are concerned, we are not in a position to approve or disapprove of such a move. Should you, as a Club, decide to transfer to Diamond Valley and provided the Diamond Valley Centre is prepared to accept your transfer, then there is nothing that we can or will do to stop it.
