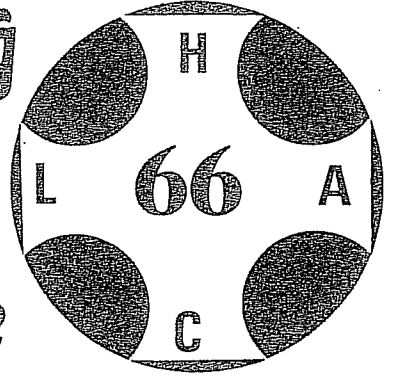

I have been asked by the Centre Executive to give you the centre's version of what has happened about the rego. mix up on Oct 7th. At the special meeting of the executive on Oct 11th a great deal of discussion took place. It is also necessary that all Centres run within the guidelines of it's constitution.

Mr. Ron Brown agreed that guidelines will have to be looked into by the Centre Executive, particularly regarding point allocation and time limit for registering club members.

Rosanna has agreed to fulfill it's obligations to the Heidelberg Centre, but should discuss in length at a later date whether it feels the need to transfer the club to another centre.

The relay morning turned out to be a fiasco as a number of the children did not get the chance to run, also some moments of unpleasantness occurred which should not have taken place.

Ruby Miller brought up the situation of a member of this club being cut quite badly by broken glass which had been left around. More care need be taken in safety around the field.

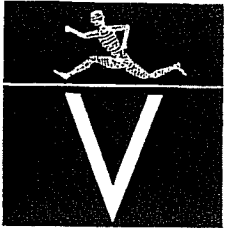
After serious consideration by our Committee and club members, it has been decided to request a transfer of our club from the Heidelberg Centre to the Diamond Valley Centre.

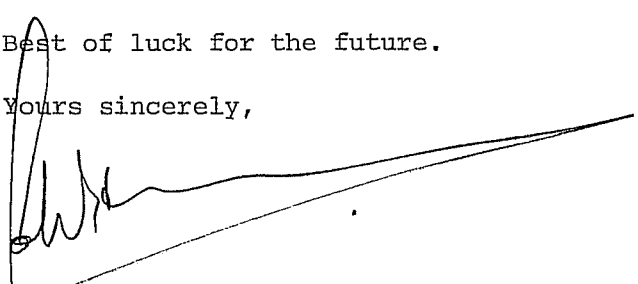
Thank you for your letter of 16th March, 1979, concerning your proposed transfer to the Diamond Valley Centre.
