General

1. Rosanna Little Athletics Club is to celebrate their 25th Anniversary in the season 1995-96 at Wilinda Park in October 1995 in accordance with References A and B.

Aim

2. The aim of this instruction is to detail the personnel, administrative and logistic support required to conduct the event.

General Outline

3. The occasion is to be celebrated on the completion of the competition morning with a barbecue luncheon, light refreshments, fun activities, presentation of certificates and a cutting of the cake to recognise the clubs birthday.

Participants

4. All registered children and families are invited to attend and join invited past members and selected members of the DVLAC in this special day to commemorate the clubs birthday.

Activities

- 5. The boys Team manager is responsible for nominating members to conduct the following games on completion of the mornings competition enabling other members to set up for the barbecue luncheon:
- a. Flag race b. Tugowar c. Gum boot throwing -
- d. Sack race e. Parents relay -

Costing

6. The cost for each family is expected not to exceed \$5 per family with an additional charge applied for other family members who attend. Invited guests from Clubs within the DVLC are to be invited with Rosanna Club to pay their fee.

Sponsors

7. The Secretary is to write a letter to all Club Sponsors inviting them to attend the occasion. To allow for final figures for catering purposes, names are to be into the committee no later than —— September 1995.

Presentations

8. It is intended to invite the first president and committee to make the presentation to the children acknowledging the 25 years of the club.

Display

9. Mrs Patsy Keall is to arrange for the Clubs History and achieves to be displayed for all members to see.

Public Relations

- 10. The Secretary is to arrange for the following:
- a. Local newspaper coverage,
- b. Local radio coverage (including interview's with original executive committee members),
- c. DVLA Centre coverage, and
- d. Club newsletter advising members of the event on sign on day.

Invitations

11. The Club Committee members are to decide who is to be invited to the occasion and the secretary is to write invitations to those personnel requesting RSVPs in a time frame to allow for catering.

Catering

- 12. Nominated Committee members are to approach the Club Sponsors for donations for the barbecue food stuffs and also for ordering and picking up drinks. The following personnel are required:
- a. Preparing salads x 4;
- b. Cooking barbecue x 3;
- o. Golling Drinks x 2; and
- d. Selling barbecue tickets x 1.

Anniversary Cake

13. A anniversary cake displaying the years of service to Rosanna Little Athletics is to be decorated by a volunteer member of the club, all cost are to be paid for by the club. The cake is to be cut by the Inaugural Club President and the clubs youngest person in conjunction with the present Club President.

Certificate

14. A certificate acknowledging 25 years for Rosanna Little Athletic Club is to be made and presented to all registered club children by past presidents. A service will be available on the day at a small cost for children to have their certificates laminated after they are presented. A nominated member of the committee is responsible for producing the certificate and arranging for the production of the number of copies required.

Wet Weather Plan

15. In case of inclement weather and the competition being cancelled for the centre, an alternate modified activity is still to be conducted at the nominated time in the centres club room at Wilinda Park. The Secretary is to advise the local radio announcer of the of the function continuing should the competition be cancelled.

Coordination

16. The celebration of the anniversary is to be coordinated by a subcommittee under direction of the Club Committee and it is to be nominated no later than 1 August 1995.

Conclusion

17. To enable the 25th anniversary to be successful all committee members are encouraged to give maximum support to this occasion and show the past and present members that we as a club have the commitment to our children today as they did in 1970.
