ANNUAL REPORT 1984/85

Another successful and rewarding year has come to an end. This is due to the efforts of both the children and parents who attended and were willing to do their bit on Saturday Mornings

I feel our Special thank's should go to Mr Jeff Franklin who attended and put every effort into making the venue run smoothly on saturday morning's and for his immense help to the committee during the year.

FINANCIAL

Club funds as at 22 MARCH 1985 total \$1465.10 . A detailed statement of Income and Expenditure is attached to this report and can be summarized as follows:-

Total income for the season of \$6111.76 is up on last year by approx. \$1900.00. This was largely due to the efforts of Mrs Linda Sansome through her fundraising activities together with increased registration fees and increased membership.

Total Expenditure was \$5425.54, the major included the various fees payable to the Diamond Valley Centre (\$3339.20), Uniforms (\$924.75) and Presentation night (\$534.22)

In summary we finished the season \$686.22 up on the starting balance of \$778.88 which must be considered satisfactory.

MEMBERSHIP

Total registrations were up by 12% on last year to a total of 158. Reregistration's accounted for 86 (61% of last years members returned) together with 72 new members. Attendance was very good with an overall average of 111 children per week. The Club being the largest at the Diamond Valley Centre for the second consecutive year.

TRAINING

The success of training during the season was due to the unselfish work of a few dedicated parents. Particular mention and our thanks should go to Greame Lyons and Rod Yin for being the backbone of our training nights this past season.

Club Awards

Each child who competes for the club during the season is presented with a medal in recognition of his/her efforts.
To win a gold, silver or bronze medal in an age group a child must have:-

- 1) Attained a standard of excellence by scoring a minimum total of points accrued over the season.
- 2) Scored first, second or third highest points in a particular age group over the determined number of events during the season.
- 3) Competed on a minimum number of events both before and after the Christmas break.

The points are Awarded on the pentathlon system for events contested. Our club "POINTS SCORER" calculates and collates the points earned by each child to determine the medal winners. My thanks to Bob Symons for a difficult Job well done.

For a complete list of medal winners refer to attachments to this report. Which will be available after presentation of trophies.

In concluding this report, I congratulate the Rosanna Little Athletes on their excellent performances and improvement over the season and my sincere thanks to the Parents that were willing to help both on competition days & with training on Wednesday's.

Whilst very few children can be club champions, each child should be very proud of their achievements and personal best performances during the season and look forward to doing even better next year.
