SCORING SYSTEM FOR AWARDS

Each child who competes for the Club during the season is presented with a medal in recognition of his/her efforts.

To win a gold, silver or bronze medal in an age group, a child must have:- Attended a minimum number of weeks for the season, ie four weeks before
Christmas and three after.

- Scored first, second, or third highest points score in a particular age group over the determined number of events during the season.

The points are awarded on the pentathlon system for events contested. The points scorer calculates the accumulated points for each competitor to determine the medal winners.

AMENDMENT TO CONSTIUTION

Item no. 8 of the Club constitution presently reads as follows :-

"The Committee shall meet as determined by the President or a majority of the Committee at a time and place decided by the Secretary and shall be a valid meeting attended by not less than half of elected members."

An amendment has been proposed by the Committee:
" is a valid meeting when attended by not less than six of the elected committee members including at least three of the executive committee members."

Gold Star Awards

The foregoing details those competitors who have been successful in awards, record-breaking or Centre representation, however, the most important aspect of all is the "gold star", which was introduced some years ago. A gold star recognises a personal best for the season, and surely, if a competitor has achieved a personal best performance, then nothing more can be expected. Many gold stars are awarded each Saturday.

Presentation Medals

For some years the Club has expressed the desire to improve the standard of medals presented to the winners in each age group. Tonight we are fortunate to have the new medals available. An extraordinary amount of effort has been expended by Graeme Lyons, from design through to direct liaison with the manufacturer, and my sincere thanks is expressed to Graeme for such a wonderful end result.

Parental Participation

In my opening remarks I referred to family participation. It has been most gratifying to see so many parents, Committee members or not, assist in the wide variety of tasks whether it be during Saturday competition, or mid-week for some other activity. Little Athletics must have direct assistance from parents to function, and quite apart from this, the children require moral support from parents who are present at Willinda Park on Saturday morning.

Thank you to one and all who have contributed in so many ways to achieving such a successful season.

Several children won't be returning next season for a variety of reasons - the Under 15's who are now ineligible to compete, those families who are moving interstate, or those who won't be re-joining us for other reasons.

To all those families, the Club wishes to acknowledge your participation and support and hope that you will continue in active sporting competition.
