



TEAM MANAGERS REPORT - SEASON 2005/2006

It has been another very successful year for athletes in the Club. With over 80 registrations we regularly had 55 – 60 athletes compete week in week out. The improvement in performance this year of many athletes was outstanding – with many getting a 20 per cent improvement in performance in events between the start and the end of the season.

I would encourage parents to review their athletes performance journey over the season with them.

The number of personal best performances by athletes each week continued to grow as the season went on -I kept having to go to the newsagent constantly throughout the season to get replacement "stars".

The interclub relay events were a highlight of the year with a number of Rosanna teams in the medals.

Medals in this seasons Centre Championships were won by Danyon Reinbold, Natalie Starr, Hemi Raheke, Tim Kuek, Laurence Schubert, Jade Crabtree, Greg Beriman, Peter Bovo, Olivia Reinbold, Alex Copeland, Kara Harbinson, Stephanie Arrowsmith, Patrick Donnelley, Hayley Van Zuylekom, Clare Greenwood, Alex Copeland, Kate Van Zylekom and Giles Richardson.

We had athletes compete successfully at region and state relays, the region and state multi event and at the State championships.

Stand out performances at the higher level of little aths came from Jade Crabtree - first in the State Multi event for U10 girls and second in the State in the U10 girls 80 hurdles, and Laurence Schubert – second in the State Multi event for the U10 boys, and first in the State for the U10 boys 80 Hurdles.

Club records were set by Laurence in the U10 boys 200m, and 80 Hurdles; by Jade in the U10 girls 80 Hurdles; and Olivia Getson in the U12 girls Hurdles.

Centre records were set by Laurence in the BU10 80 Hurdles and by Jade in the GU10 Multi Event.
